WELCOME TO THE 2ND ANNUAL **PARA-BADMINTON NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

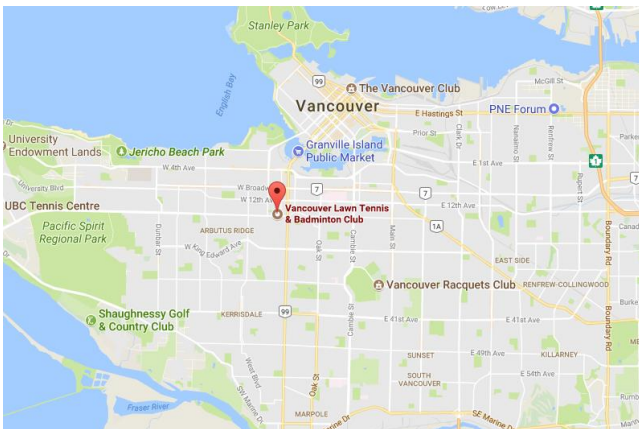

PARKING: Guests are permitted to park in the front parking lot, the covered parking and roof top lots. Guests are required to sign-in their vehicles at the Front Desk.

There are multiple accessible washrooms and showering facilities within the club. On the main floor, there is one private accessible washroom, with several options on the lower level that can be accessed. Participants will receive a map indicating locations in their registration package.



CATEGORIES: PARA-BADMINTON

The Badminton World Federation recognizes six classification groups, as listed below including general guidelines for disabilities:

Wheelchair WH1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spinal injury causing impairment to upper limbs/trunk • Scoliosis • Multiple Sclerosis
Wheelchair WH2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spinal Injury causing lower impairment to upper limbs/trunk • Spina Bifida • Above knee amputation necessitating use of a wheelchair
Standing SL3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single Above Knee amputation • Double Below Knee amputation • Cerebral Palsy
Standing SL4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single Below Knee amputation • Cerebral Palsy • Hip dysplasia • Leg length difference (of minimum 7cm)
Standing SU5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upper limb amputation • Upper limb impairment – e.g brachial plexus injury
Short Stature SS6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short Stature/dwarf condition – e.g. achondraplasia

MINIMUM ENTRIES

If there are less than four (4) entries in a particular event, events may be combined – Sport Classes and or men & women – in accordance with Para-Badminton Competition Regulation 5.1.5.1

Doubles pairs can be made according to the table above. If there are questions or concerns regarding doubles pairs, please contact the tournament chair, or contact the Badminton Canada offices.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Participation is open to all players with a disability which has been confirmed and documented by a physician, and falls into one of the six para-badminton classifications. All athletes **must be a Canadian citizen**, and will have to show their passport onsite before the start of competition.

REGISTRATION, ENTRY FEES & DEADLINES

ENTRY FEES

A cost of \$150 is requested in order to compete in the tournament. This registration fee includes:

- A Provincial & National membership
- Playing up to 3 events
- Feather Black Knight shuttles for warm-up and competition
- Social event on the Saturday night including a banquet dinner
- Tournament souvenir

REGISTRATION PROCESS

All athletes interested in participating in the 2017 Para-badminton Nationals Championships must submit each of the following items to badminton@badminton.ca by August 25th 2017 to ensure they are properly registered for the event:

1. If an athlete has not yet been officially classified as per the BWF guidelines and policies, they must complete and submit the classification form - <http://www.badminton.ca/page/31481/Classification>

DEADLINES

All registration items and fees must be submitted to badminton@badminton.ca by no later than **August 25th 2017 at 11:59PM EST**. Unpaid entries will not be included in the draws. **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Changes are NOT permitted after the entry deadline. In the event of Doubles and Mixed Doubles, both players must be entered before the entry deadline.

WITHDRAWALS

Withdrawals are permitted up to the date of registration deadline. Refunds for withdrawals are provided less a 25% administration fee for participants who withdraw prior to the entry deadline of the competition. Refunds will not be provided for withdrawals after the entry deadline.

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

COMPETITION FORMAT

The 21- Rally Point scoring format will be utilized. Three-minute warm-up and ten-minute default will be strictly enforced.

Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time. Failure to be ready to play when called will result in disqualification.

CLUB REGULATIONS

The following policies will be strictly enforced by the Vancouver Lawn Tennis & Badminton Club:

1. Players must wear appropriate racquets clothing that is predominately white. Each article of visible clothing, excluding shoes, may not have more than 10% colour. This includes hats and warm-up suits.
2. Shoes with soles that mark the court are not permitted.
3. Cell phones must be kept on mute. It is prohibited to talk on a cell phone or hold a cell phone to your ear in the Club, even to check messages. Texting is permitted.

CLOTHING & ADVERTISING

All athletes and coaches participating in any sanctioned Para-Badminton National Championship will be restricted to having their LAST NAME on their competitive clothing. The athlete clothing is not required to have any indicators on their competitive uniforms.

AWARDS

National Championship Medals will be presented. Other prizes to be confirmed

TOURNAMENT ACCOMMODATIONS
